For each of the books read, please complete the following questions to use as a helpful tool with an in class essay upon returning to school. **The answers to these questions are due within the first week of school (for credit) and the in class essay will be given by the end of week two as a test grade.** ** Therefore, the reading **must be done** so that the student can be prepared to pass the test.

1. Describe the main characters in the novel citing examples as evidence. Explain how these characters change/develop over the course of the novel. Explain any important interactions with other characters and some problems that the character may have.
2. Describe the setting (time & place) and explain the importance (of the time and place) to the characters in the novel and how it affects their situation/problem.
3. Summarize the main ideas and details of the novel by making notes about what was read so that it can be referred back to for the test.
4. Recommend the novel to another reader (showing how much you enjoyed it) by creating a picture (8x10) to sell the book OR write a critique explaining why you would not recommend the novel by citing specific reasons for your dislike of the book.
