

Talking to Youth About Gun Violence

Gun violence has significantly impacted our communities. As adults, we often struggle comprehending the full scale of these events. This may cause us to be reluctant to have these difficult conversations with youth. This 60-minute training is designed to help adults understand their own feelings in order to have a productive conversation about the event. We will discuss techniques for opening the conversation, maintaining open dialogue and recognizing when an advanced level of support may be needed.
